Can we provide financial support for SAM35 events at Middle Wallop and help with labor support on May 18 - June 15 - August 3 - September 7 and October 5.

The meeting concluded that we could not reliably help with labour support and also due to cuts in annual grant the financial risk support would also be difficult for all 5 days.

At the allocated cost of £125 per day 5 days risk would be £625 and with our reduced grant (1526 ) this would equate to 40% total grant - there was however commitment to support the risk for one day.

I would also like to mention the opportunities that are being presented by working with other airfield users (namely SAM35) and by supporting each other in various ways we are seeing new ventures that could again be of benefit to local model flyers.

So far a positive start to the year. If there is a concern in my mind it is that as we increase the number of events and local activity for our area members and clubs then we could see financial implications being a constraint.

This will be a topic that we will need to monitor and address during the year.

### 5.2 David Smith Vice Chairman

I represented Southern Area committee at a BMFA membership workshop in Meadstead on 28 November.

I attended the Balsa Brain quiz night on 30 November, collecting entry money and managing the raffle.

I was unable to attend the Full Council meeting on 12 January as I was unwell, but have circulated a summary report from notes provided by Duncan McClure (see para 5.7).

I attended the London Model Engineer Exhibition 17-20 January to support the BMFA stand, providing three models for the display.

I have continued to pursue the issue of poor communication from the editor of BMFA News but have had little success and will raise this again at Areas Council in March.

#### **Notes on the accounts:**

1. We continue to hold the £183.00 for the 2018 Odiham Rally. This is a S. A. Event, the licence fee has been paid and a new date is to be planned for early in 2019 due to the cancellation of the original date.
2. The 2018 Balsa Brain event went ahead as planned on the 30<sup>th</sup> November; the cost of the hall & food was down as were the takings due to the lower attendance, but remarkably the cost worked out at just £3.00 below the budgeted figure.

3. Due to there being no Special presentation (£30.00 allowed) or Bovington expenses (£35.00 allowed) claimed this year my warning of the year being run at a deficit has been much reduced. However the situation for the coming year has to assume that these cancelled items will go ahead so if nothing else changes, I predict the assets will reduce by £245.90\*.

\* We are currently reviewing what we are to budget for in 2019 / 20 so this figure is a starting point from which we finally accept.

Two Scams have been avoided, situation explained at the meeting to forewarn others.

My thanks to Duncan McClure (South Midland Area Delegate) and Peter Disney (RNMAA & South West Delegate) for the information, forming the basis of this report, as I was unwell and did not attend.

#### ASRC

The ASRC membership for 2019 is unchanged as no positions were contested. Two AS events will be held at Buckminster in 2019, and two Roadshows, one in the Northwest and one in South Wales or Western Area. See website for details. Initial phase of Continued Competence for club examiners will start this year, comprising certificates for attendance at AS events. Work continues on video guidance for the A and B tests. The AS Facebook page is proving popular and useful.

#### Treasurer's Report

Keith has been busy implementing fall-out from the AGM. Membership numbers going well so far with around 2,000 more members than same date last year. Not clear why yet, maybe that it is far easier for people to join via the new membership system.

#### SAA & LMA Insurance status

Confirmed as OK as they now mirror BMFA, although this hasn't always been the case.

#### Chairman & CEO Report

David continues to be extremely busy on BMFA business safeguarding **ALL** forms of aero modelling in the UK, including involvement with high-level Governmental Drone legislation. 2019 will be a critical year for model flying in the UK. The change in air law identified in CAP 1687 will come into effect in November 2019. Salient points are:

All model flyers will have to be registered.

No cost for registration to flow back to Government, hence a fee is likely.

There will be a competency element – likely exemption for achievement holders.

Exemptions likely for control line and indoor flying.

CEO attending ASRC meeting 19 January to consider implications.

A working group chaired by the Records Officer to be established shortly to explore feasibility of Charitable Status for Buckminster.

New membership system is working very well from HQ perspective, saving considerable time and postal charges. The software developers quickly address any issues.

Industry reports that the drone market is 25% of what it was two years ago, with the emphasis shifting firmly towards high-end professional systems.

Links with the National Trust are being re-invigorated, as they remain very positive towards model flying on NT land.

LMA now a registered company with Chacksfield House as registered office.

Buckminster bookings for 2019 are buoyant. £18,000 has been donated towards establishing the control line circles. Planning application for camp site approved. Buckminster to be marked on aeronautical charts – small circle with UA in the middle – UA = Unmanned Aircraft.

Insurers have indicated that providing there are no last-minute claims, a rebate at some level is likely, but we won't know the exact situation until at least March.

### **Vice Chair report**

Safety review committee responsibility passed to Areas Council, as more appropriate than with Tech Council. New Safety Committee to be formed, with direct input to Member's Handbook.

General agreement that Member's Handbook should be solely electronic and available only on-line in the future.

### **Hon Sec report**

Area funding is under review and will feature at Areas Council meeting in March. Area funds currently based on the number of affiliated clubs, not club members. The BFPVRA has changed its name to British Drone Racing Association (BDRA).

### **5.8 Roger Newman Free flight comp.**

Very little activity since the AGM annual report on the flying side, but movements on the organisational front – some good, some not so good.

SAM1066 has been granted two days at Middle Wallop, subject to licence approval. Fees have been set that could be punitive if the weather is bad, but we are willing to take a chance. Total cost is £125 per day fixed fee plus £180 for a licence & £30 MoD insurance contribution = total of £460. First meeting is for competition only & if successful sets the ground for competition & sports flying for the second meeting. An overall 250 gram weight limit for models has been imposed, in order to avoid any complications with pending drone legislation; this gives sufficient scope for a variety of comps.

There will be limited access to Area 8 of Salisbury Plain for the first seven months of the year, due to the MoD granting permission to a film company to shoot a film about WW1. Initially there was to be a complete ban, but it now seems that access will be made available on certain weekends.

Permission has been granted for a day at RAF Odiham – now set for 12<sup>th</sup> May (date subject to confirmation), to hold the event that was cancelled due to bad weather last autumn.

This is subject to DIO agreeing to carry the paid for licence forward. The proposed second day, in the autumn, has been abandoned as the FFTC rescheduled its calendar following Salisbury Plain activities & has set the same date for the London Gala as was planned for Odiham.

A comp schedule is attached with this report. It is planned to experiment with a "Cagnarata" or fun fly competitive event, where a variety of classes can be flown in a single comp, with each class of model being factored for performance. The concept is to encourage more entries. There are 15 events planned for the year, inclusive of Area events.

SAM 1066 reviewed the HMG response to its recent consultation on drones & has now written to the BMFA (David Phipps) to raise queries as to the complete lack of clarity concerning free flight & the processes for registration & certificate of competency now written into the ANO that become effective on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2019. As yet, no answers have been received.

### **5.9 Terry Weeks Alton Silent Flyers, Club-delegate reports.**

#### **Silent Flight & S A Committee Member Reports.**

The Alton Silent Flyers have agreed the following dates for the 2019 Esoaring League arranged to not clash with other similar events, they are: 26<sup>th</sup> May; 9<sup>th</sup> June; 21<sup>st</sup> July and the 8<sup>th</sup> September.

I attended the Balsa Brain event and acted as the question master, all 5 of the rounds I had prepared being used, and apart from a minor problem with round 2 it went well with many kind comments being received. It did involve visiting Hedge End prior to the event to ensure compatibility with the projector.

I would like to thank Peter Willis and Dave Smith for stepping up to the mark in selling the raffle tickets and collecting the £1.00 entrance fees that I normally take care of.

For the sake of independence can I suggest we consider buying our own projector for events such as these, it would also be useful if we ran another S A Seminar at Middle Wallop like we did once before.

I attended the LMEE for the set-up on the Thursday with Dave, Tony & Roger, Dave and I stayed for the whole 4 days and was re-joined by Tony and Roger on the Sunday and the stand break down. All in all the show was well worth attending with lots of interest.

Due to the recent high publicity of multi-rotor activity in the news it was very interesting and rewarding to note that the general public are more than aware of the difference between the safety conduct of the general aeromodelling fraternity and the annoyance caused by a few rogue multi-rotor flyers, some quite aggressively asking what is being done to prevent the annoyance caused.

Still not even an acknowledgement from Peter Dodds (BMFA Newsletter Editor) regarding the submitted report on Alex Savill's "A" test success or any other submitted reports.

I have been contacted by Joe regarding Wartime Wallop 2019 and have agreed we will attend both the event and prior meetings, to be discussed tonight in AOB both for our arrangements and in answer to their request for further modelling input. I have already suggested model tanks but need a contact to pass on to Joe.
