4.1 Southern Area AGM Wednesday 13th November 2019 preparation

Peter Turley is standing down from the committee after some 12 years, with vacancies for Hon. Sec. and PRO.

Peter Turley has seen Stuart Simpson recently and he has asked me to advise the committee that he wishes to stand down from the committee at the AGM, because of the difficulty in getting to the meetings as currently he cannot drive himself.

5.0 (Agenda Item 6) Officers Reports)

5.1 Tony Butterworth Chairman

Attended the Power Nationals once again supported by several members from down South and can report the campsite team airfield responsibilities were completed without issues this year. The weather was excellent and although numbers appeared to be slightly down from previous years the event was well supported by both competitors and visitors.

At the end of the event my conversations with the local management advised they were very complimentary of our management of the site over the duration of the event and looked forward to welcoming us back next year.

Maintaining a positive relationship with Barkston Heath not only support future nationals but also acts as a positive reference when we are talking to other airfields re potential future use.

It was also positive that we welcomed members from the CAA as VIP guests during the weekend providing the opportunity to showcase our sport and its many classes, I am advised this went well.

The recent notification from Middle Wallop to cease model flying on the airfield at the end of the year did come as a shock - all the hard work we have completed over the past years appears to have been in vein.

However I do know that moves are afoot to open negotiations with MW and also to explore other facilities in the local area for model flying in the future.

On this note SAM35 events - some 10 days in all - have been well supported.



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Attended the budget review (grant submission 2020) with Terry, David and Peter T - considering the level of activity we complete within the area the requested increase submitted was realistic - this increase if achieved will stop the annual reduction in area funds and will enable us to plan for the future with a higher level of confidence in being able to support area events and local clubs when they need financial help.

Have spoken with Firebirds and Balsa brain has been booked for 8th November - same location as previous years.

Finally spoke with Dave Phipps at nationals re update on UK regulations , although many hurdles still existed there was some light at the end of the tunnel and I sensed cause for a small level of optimism, let's hope so.

5.2 David Smith Vice Chairman

I attended the Meadstead RC Model Show on 3/4 August to run a SABMFA stand (including a flight simulator), with thanks to Ken Gale and Terry Weeks for their help with this.

I also helped Peter Willis to set up a BMFA display at the Dorset Model Swapmeet.

I have provided a collection of questions to Terry Weeks in preparation for the Balsa Brain quiz.

Also drafted the SABMFA budget proposal for 2020-21 before submitting the final version to the Hon Sec in preparation for Areas Council.

I have submitted my Directors Report for the 2019 BMFA AGM, and will attend the BMFA Full Council meeting on 14 September.

5.3 Terry Weeks Hon. Treasurer

Please refer to the balance sheets, following our meeting at the west Meon Hut on the 3rd September these have been considerably amended to conform to the discussion held and budget proposals put forward to BMFA HQ.

Notes on the accounts:

1. This financial year is shown on page 8 (the second sheet of the balance sheet) and as you can see by the few items that remain in red, is almost complete with only Balsa Brain left as a major expenditure and the AGM and January meeting room hire remaining. We still have an allowance for a roadshow / workshop that to date has not been planned included as a possible expenditure.

2. For the year April 2020 until March 2021 the figures show the items budgeted for and the requirement for the grant to increase by c£760.00 if we are to achieve it, the outcome of the BMFA HQ debate on this subject remains to be seen. On paper the idea of increasing the grant on the active areas and reducing the grant on the less active areas is a good one, but good ideas are not always adopted. We have reduced the web-site funding to cover an interim period of changeover to the cost-free BMFA hosted site, on the assumption that this happens, I will keep pushing for it with Andy Symons. 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5.4 Peter Turley Hon. Sec. report.

After reviewing again at the last meeting, I have decided to stand down from the committee at the AGM in November this year after some 12 years on the committee and 19 years supporting the SA initially via PAM.

Have seen Stuart Simpson since the Nationals and he has asked me to advise the committee that he wishes to stand down from the committee at the AGM, because of the difficulty in getting to the meetings as currently he cannot drive and lack of access to the meeting room.

It is the 15th year, that I have support Tony Butterworth running the Power National's camp site, with a new tent. Out of the 15 years I think it was the best weather of all times.

Two members of CADMAC took part in the Nationals, one in Vintage Control line and the other in the Fun fly event in class two came 6th out of 15 and in the climb and glide, won the event.

I attended the Southern Area funding meeting at the Meon Hut on the 3rd September.

I have supported CADMAC static show at the Thorney Families day last weekend.

The next CADMAC event is the Remembrance Day Glider Fly in and donations to the Poppy Fund.

5.5 ASC co-ordinator and FW Comp. Sec. Report Peter Willis

1. AS Coord. Attended Buckminster for the Achievement Scheme Fly In and coaching weekend on Saturday 4th and Sunday 5th August 2019. Weather forecast was good and we had a very good turnout for the weekend with several test being undertaken including an Aerobatic C and a S Area Club Examiner test.
2. FW Comp Rep/AS Coord. attended the Dorset Swap Meet along with Terry Weeks and Dave Smith to represent the S Area BMFA on Saturday 7th September. Numbers were not great (60 buyers and approx. 10 selling tables) but the event broke even and an email of thanks has been received from James Parry. They are planning on holding another next May with wider publicity and S. Area will be invited along again.
3. FW Comp Rep/AS Coord. has received a response from local MP Michael Tomlinson MP during the last week of August following meeting with him on Friday 21st June. Letter really just forwarded the Secretary for State's response (Baroness Vere) to his enquiries, which did not differ from previous response received direct from Baroness Vere's office. However, Grant Shapps has now replaced Baroness Vere and Dave Phipps (BMFA CEO) is holding numerous meetings with the various departments and ministry in a last ditch attempt to head off some of the less sensible proposals.

5.9 Terry Weeks Alton Silent Flyers, Club-delegate reports.

The last of the planned 4 National Esoaring Opens took place on the 8th September as planned and this year we have been lucky as all 4 enjoyed good weather. The final winner was Mike Raybone with 14982, 2nd Chris Foss with 14973 and 3rd Terry Stucky 14814, as you can see really tight with only 9 point separating the top two over the four rounds. The trophies presented were well received by the eventual winners.

I joined David and Ken at the Meadstead model show on Saturday 3rd August, this has the potential to grow to a bigger event, so I intend for one to keep my club calendar free of next year's date.

On the 3rd September I had a very busy day. From 10:00am until 4:00pm at the request of the MVSA Chairman Ian Shilling I attended an "A" test day for the slope soaring lads.

12 tests were taken and successfully passed; this followed a talk I gave at the MVSA club night on the 10th July. I was really impressed at the level of attention given to the preparation by all of the candidates.

A further 10 or so are lined up for a future date yet to be arranged, followed by some "B" tests and finally some examiner tests in the more distant future.

At 6:00pm rather than go home after the above I met Peter Turley at the West Meon Hut to have dinner in advance of the Area budget meeting mentioned in Para 5.3.

I joined Peter Willis at the Dorset Area Swapmeet at Spetisbury on the 7th September to man the BMFA stand; this was well received and again has the potential to expand in future years.

MVSA: The main item to note is that mentioned above, longer term the club is to drop its own achievement test in favour of all taking the BMFA "A" test as a minimum standard to fly solo.

Skylarks: As with the MVSA, Keith the secretary / chairman is continuing with the push to get all members, now 51 by the way, to pass their "A" test under the threat of not being allowed to fly unaccompanied after December 31st.

ASF: As above the 2019 season of running a series of Esoaring league competitions on behalf of the S. Area is now complete and all look forward to 2020 season.
